

SEDATION REQUIREMENTS (For Non-Anesthesiologists)**Initial Requirements for Administration of Moderate Sedation and Analgesia**

- *Completion of privilege profile.
- *Completion of appropriate Learning Exchange module(s) (Within the last 24 months)
- *Maintenance of advanced life support certification as appropriate to specialty (ACLS|PALS|ATLS|NRP) - ED Providers are exempt if board certified/eligible
- FPPE Plan required in Five (5) proctored sedation cases (by a member of staff with Moderate Sedation Privileges)

Reappointment Requirements for Administration of Moderate Sedation and Analgesia

- *Completion of privilege profile.
 - *Completion of Learning Exchange module(s) as needed for initial privileging (within the last 24 months)
 - *Maintenance of advanced life support certification as appropriate to specialty (ACLS|PALS|ATLS|NRP) - ED Providers are exempt if board certified/eligible
 - Completion of at least 25 Moderate Sedation cases each OR
 - Completion of at least 10 Moderate Sedation cases each cycle AND completion of Simulation Lab certification (within the last 24 months).
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Initial Requirements for Administration of Deep Sedation

- *Currently hold Administration of Moderate Sedation and Analgesia Privileges
- *Completed Privilege Profile
- *Maintenance of advanced life support certification as appropriate to specialty (ACLS|PALS|ATLS|NRP) - ED Providers are exempt if board certified/eligible
- Completion of appropriate Learning Exchange module(s) (within the last 24 months)
- Completion of Simulation Lab Training (Certificate) (within the last 24 months)

Reappointment Requirements for Administration of Deep Sedation

- *Completed privilege profile
- *Completion of appropriate Learning Exchange module(s) (within the last 24 months)
- *Maintenance of advanced life support certification as appropriate to specialty (ACLS|PALS|ATLS|NRP) - ED Providers are exempt if board certified/eligible
- Completion of Simulation Lab Training (Certificate) (within the last 24 months)
- Completion of at least Five (5) Deep Sedation cases per year.

Note: ED, OMFS & PICU providers must be board certified or eligible to be considered qualified thru training, and are exempt from initial and renewal requirements, except for the Learning Exchange modules and astericked (*) items. (OMFS must complete 5 intubations/LMA placements per year & maintain internal log). PICU APPs- Moderate- must complete astericked (*) items, Learning Exchange and 5 proctored cases/FPPE at Initial and 10 cases annually at renewal. Deep- must complete all requirements and 3 proctored cases/FPPE at Initials and complete all requirements at renewal.
